# Oakwood Clock Restoration Appeal for Funds

As a resident, local business or frequent visitor you probably know that Oakwood Clock is in desperate need of major repairs. Oakwood Clock is a familiar landmark at the southern end of Roundhay Park and provides a meeting place, a location for the farmers' market, a name for the bus stop and road junction and even tells us the time.

Oakwood Traders and Residents Association (OTRA) has formed a subcommittee to raise funds and to work with Leeds City Council in taking urgent action on repairs before the clock deteriorates to a state where it can no longer be restored. OTRA is working closely with the three local Councillors and officers of the Council.

The funds needed are well over £100,000 and to date approximately £25,000 has been raised or promised. Fund raising events have taken place and further events and awareness raising activities are planned.
